



Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

This year we are offering a new form of **Academic Intervention**.

In order to better serve the needs of the students, and to provide support for the students that may need or require it, MCHS will be utilizing Friday late starts to provide extra assistance to students through Office Hours and the Learning Center.

Students may be required to use the Learning Center on Friday morning if they are on academic probation, if they are in danger of failing of class, or are failing a class.

Students may be referred to the Learning Center on Friday morning if they are missing class work, need to make up or retake an exam or quiz, or are recommended to the Learning Center based on their subject teacher's discretion.

The work, assignments, and assessments that need to be completed will be available in the Learning Center for the student to complete Friday morning prior to the start of class. The learning center opens at 7:45 am, allowing students over an hour of in which they can complete their work.

Students and parents will be notified early in the week if they are recommended or required to use the Learning Center.

Office Hours:

In order to better serve the needs of the students, and to provide support for the students that may need or require it, MCHS will be utilizing Friday late starts to provide extra assistance to students through Office Hours and the Learning Center.

Students may be required to use Office Hours on Friday morning if they are on academic probation, if they are in danger of failing a class, are failing a class, or require additional one-on-one support or guidance in order to complete assignments.

Students may be recommended to attend a teachers Office Hours on Friday morning if they are missing class work, need to make up or retake an exam or quiz, or require additional one-on-one interaction and guidance.

Students that are recommended or required to attend a teachers Office Hours will sign in upon arrival and sign out after they have finished meeting with their teacher.

Students and parents will be notified early in the week if they are recommended or required to use the Learning Center.
